HOW TO GET THERE

FROM THE AIRPORT

From the Barajas Airport, you may take a taxi or opt for the tube (Metro). If taking the Metro, take line 8 (the pink line, towards Mar de Cristal), to the Nuevos Ministerios stop. There, you will connect with Line 6 (grey line, to Manuel Becerra). Finally, from Manuel Becerra take Line 2 (red line), and get off at Estación de Sevilla.

GETTING AROUND THE CITY ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Bus lines: Lines 10, 151 and 12 all stop at the Plaza de Sol. Lines 5 and 120 will leave you in the Plaza de Antón Martín. Lines 6, 50 and 65 will take you to the Plaza de Canalejas. Closest Metro stops: Sol, Antón Martín and Sevilla.
