## MUST

### PESCHERIA SAN PIETRO

Exquisite design and sublime food. You can see how they make their own pasta through the window. A top must.



### REST. TRATTORIA ANGIOLINO

Here speciality and tradition command: you've got to eat a bistecca fiorentina. Really, really good meat.

### LA CARRAIA

Ice cream in a thousand and one flavours. Creamy and delicious. Who can resist a sweet in the country of gelato?

### MOYO

Here is where Florentines have their aperitif, the cocktail before dinner. In addition to drinks, they also serve a very good brunch.

### RISTORANTE CIRO & SONGS

An 18th-century palace full of mural paintings. You can get amazing pizza here.



### VINOTECA I DUE FRATELLINI

A small bar serving wines and pannini. Open since 1875. There's a reason for that.

### TRATTORIA MODERNA I RADDI

Delicious local food and good Tuscan wines. Eat in this osteria to feel like a real Italian.



### GELATERIA DELLA PASSERA

Artisanal ice-cream at very affordable prices, in such exotic flavours as fig. Trying it is a must.

### YAB CLUB

The fashionable disco in Florence. Elegant and exclusive, it offers the famous Florentine aperitif, live music, and famous DJs.

### PONTE VECCHIO

The oldest stone bridge in Europe. It houses many shops because, according to legend, their location made them tax-free.

### MERCATO NUOVO

Or the Porcellino market. Rubbing the snout of the sculpture of a wild boar in this market brings good luck. You decide what to ask.

### PALAZZO PITTI



The home of great dukes and illustrious Florentine figures is now one of the largest art galleries in town.

### BOBOLI GARDENS

Next to Palazzo Pitti, this garden shows the opulence of the Medici, the noble family that controlled Florence in the past.

### PIAZZALE MICHELANGELO

This is the perfect place to admire a sunset and see an amazing view of the Tuscan capital.

### SANTA MARIA DEL FIORE

A masterpiece of Gothic art and the Italian Renaissance. Brunelleschi's dome is an architectural milestone.

### BASILICA DI SAN LORENZO

Amazing domes and colours in a stunning building. Also by Brunelleschi.

### PIAZZA DELLA SIGNORIA

The central square in Florence. Here is Palazzo Vecchio, 50% museum, 50% town hall, and 100% a symbol of Florence.

### GALLERIA DEGLI UFFIZI



This palace commissioned by the Medici (like almost everything in this town) houses one of the oldest and most famous art collections in the world.

### GALLERIA DELLA ACADEMIA DI FIRENZE

It houses Michelangelo's David. Need we say more?
